| LEAGUE DESCRIPTION | The Santa Clara Valley Rifle League (SCVRL) is open to all Smallbore (.22) Rifle and Air Rifle shooters interested in marksmanship and competition in the 3-position and silhouette disciplines. Whether you have an off-the-shelf Ruger 10/22 or an Olympic-grade Anschutz, you'll enjoy improving your marksmanship skills while competing in our friendly, low-pressure, league. |
| MATCH DATES | 1 st and 3 rd Thursdays of the month from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm (see reverse for a schedule of dates). Matches begin on November 5, 2015 and continue through April 21, 2016. Twelve matches total. |
| COURSE OF FIRE | Traditional league events: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3-position (prone, kneeling & standing), 10 shots per position, A-17 target • One position using the A-17 target, followed by two standing silhouette (TQ-14) targets Optional event: shooter's preference, three targets max. (e.g., 3-P air rifle using AR-5/10). Shooters must complete their course of fire in 36 minutes. |
| LEAGUE FEES | Adults: \$85.00. Juniors: \$15.00. Includes twelve matches and the end-of-season dinner. Fees are due at the first match. |
| AMMUNITION | Shooters provide their own ammunition. |
| TARGETS | The league provides official, 50-foot, NRA A-17 10-bull and NRA TQ-14 silhouette targets. Only targets fired for score may be posted downrange. |
| RELAYS | First relay begins at 5:00 PM and the final relay should be completed by 7:00 PM. Please call the range if you expect to arrive after 6:00 PM, phone: (408) 275-1738. |
| SQUADDING | Sign sheet at time of picking up targets. <u>Scheduled match shooters</u> have preference for firing over absentee, make-up or guest shooters. |
| SCORES | A-17 targets scored per NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules; TQ-14 silhouette targets scored per league rules. Leave both score sheets in folder provided in the locker. |
| MAKE-UP TARGETS | For individual scores only: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Make-up targets to be fired under match conditions. 2. Make-up targets to be dated when fired and to be dated for the designated match. 3. Make-up targets to be signed and witnessed by another league member. |
| AWARDS | No awards or trophies will be awarded; instead, the league will host an end-of-season dinner. |
